



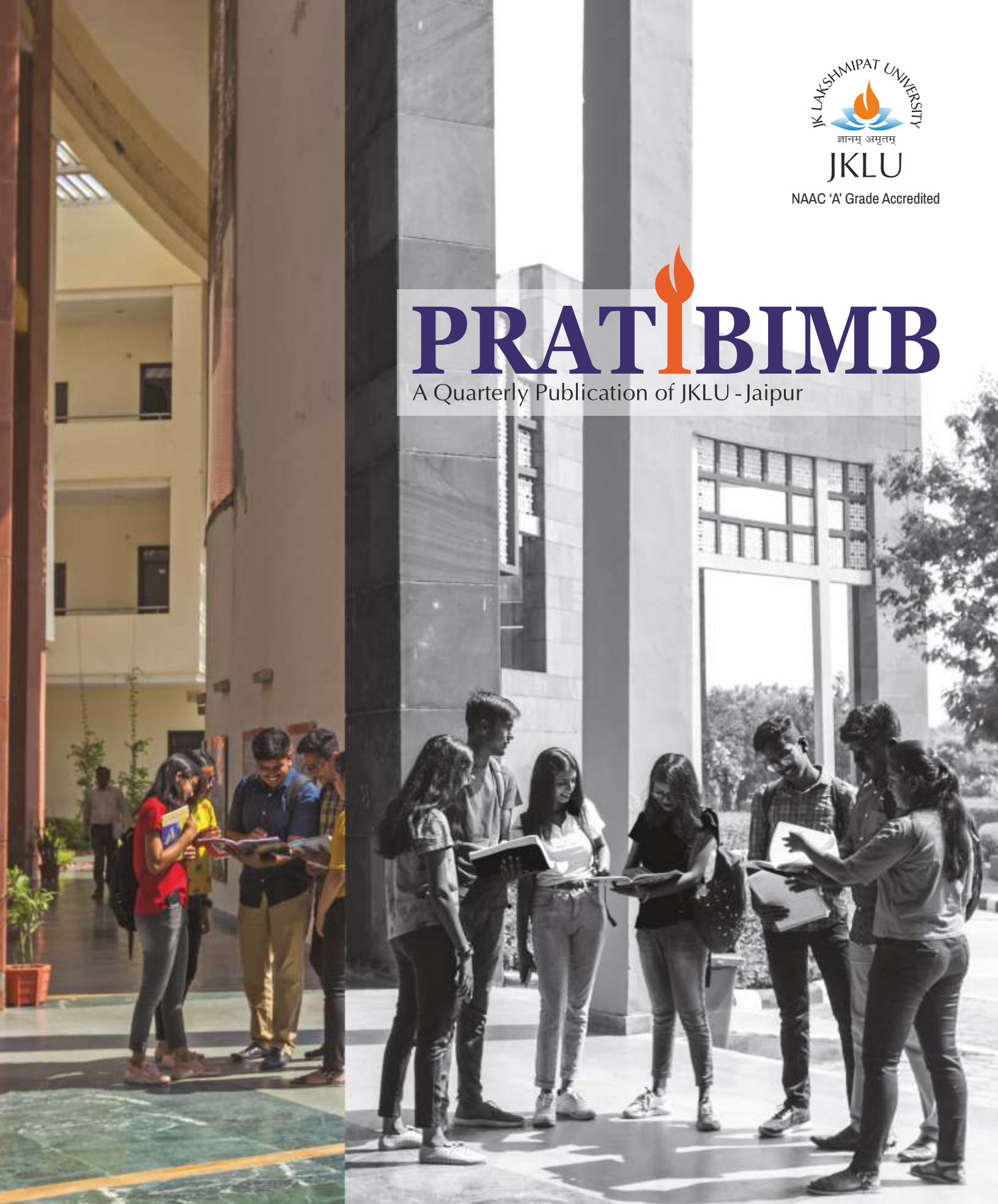

TENTH CONVOCATION AND FOUNDER'S DAY

JK Lakshmipat University (JKLU) celebrated its Tenth Convocation Day on November 23, 2022 in the presence of Chief Guest, NASSCOM Co-Founder and Padma Shri awardee

Shri Saurabh Srivastava. 107 students were awarded graduation and post-graduation degrees on the successful completion of BBA, B.Tech, MBA, M.Tech, PGDAR, PGDID and PhD programmes. The event also coincided with JKLU's Eleventh Founder's Day, which is celebrated on the Birth Anniversary of Lala Lakshmipat Singhania. Pro Chancellor, Dr Raghu Pati Singhania welcomed all dignitaries, guests and students at the function and paid tribute to the Founder and first Chancellor of the university, Shri Hari Shankar Singhania. He emphasized on the group's long term commitment to world-class education and spoke about the university's achievements over the last 10 years. Vice Chancellor, Prof Dheeraj Sanghi mentioned the various distinctions achieved by the university and its students over the past year. He expressed his gratitude to the chief guest for having graced the occasion and inspiring students with the wonderful motto he lives his life by. He told students that they are amongst the privileged 2-3% of youth who get the quality of education they deserve. Instead of taking it as a means to having a good life, they should think of it as a ticket to change the world for the better and their personal integrity should be above board. Chief Guest, Shri Saurabh Srivastava thanked JKLU for inviting him to the convocation and said it was always thrilling to interact with students. He said that he feels proud about having such brilliant minds running the nation in future.

Design Guru Day



JK LakshmiPat University celebrated Design Guru Day on November 9, 2022 in memory of acclaimed design educationist Late Prof MP Ranjan, on his birth anniversary. The event is dedicated to inspire the next generation of designers and recognize those who have contributed to design education in India. Organized by JKLU's Institute of Design, in collaboration with Association of Designers of India (ADI) and NID Alumni Association, this year, on its 7th edition, the award was conferred on renowned design educationist and influencer, Prof Ashoke Chatterjee, Distinguished Fellow and Senior Faculty, National Institute of Design, Ahmedabad, for his outstanding contribution in evangelizing Design and Design Education. An alumnus of St Stephen's College and Miami University, Prof Chatterjee is the former Executive Director of Communication and Management at the National Institute of Design (NID). He was also associated with the International Civil Service Commission and India Tourism Development Corporation (ITDC). He has served as the Crafts Council of India's Honorary President for more than 20 years and is also an Author. He has worked with a variety of development organizations in India and abroad, particularly in the fields of drinking water, sanitation, disability, livelihoods, and education and has worked with local artisans in different regions of the nation. Design Guru Day started with an Art Workshop by Prof Yunus Khimani, where everybody was invited to participate. Students of the Institute of Design showcased their talent through various activities, including an exhibition of their

projects, a documentary screening and sale of student merchandise. The event was held in the university campus with the main event happening in the Learning Resource Centre. On the occasion, which was attended live by over 200 design professionals, academics, university faculty, staff and students and hundreds of others on social media, Prof Chatterjee was awarded the Design Guru trophy. There were tributes from the who's who of the world of design and from design students of the university. After the welcome address by JKLU Vice Chancellor Prof Dheeraj Sanghi and Director of the Institute of Design, Prof A Balasubramaniam, Pro Vice Chancellor, Prof Asheesh Gupta read out the Citation felicitating the Design Guru. Design Guru, Prof Ashoke Chatterjee, delivered the MP Ranjan Memorial Lecture 2022 – "The Hope & the Reason: Design Education in India". During his address, while highlighting the importance of the role played by India in design education, said, "Design came to India for development. It has to be understood he that the profession was brought to this country, the only developing country in the world, under the constraints of framework in understanding what development should be. How many design schools have a theory of development? How many even use this word today?" His advice to the young designers of today was, "Ensure that your choices are honest to yourselves and honest to the beliefs of the country that gave you the opportunity to learn". The programme ended with a vote of thanks from Prof Devanuj Balkrishan, Dean, Institute of Design.

Workshop on “Web Design & Development”

Workshops on Migration and Rights

In the second workshop held on October 15, the Speaker Ms. Sarah Weiss from Heinrich Böll Stiftung, New Delhi provided an in-depth insight on the Afghan Resettlement during 2021 humanitarian crisis, while dealing India's role in the process. Around 70 students from semester V (BTech, BBA, and B.Des) attended the workshop.



Event Hosting

The Centre for Communication and Critical Thinking organised a workshop session on Event Hosting on October 12, 2022 at IET Amphitheatre. An Event Host, or MC (Master of Ceremonies), plays an understated yet critical role in any event. Such a person dons many hats: that of a genial host, an official spokesperson, a herald, a coordinator, an entertainer, and if needed, a trouble-shooter. There is a common misconception that the ability to speak well in a given language is all that an MC requires. However, this is not so. As the official face of the organising team/institution, the MC must not only be a good communicator, speaking clearly and succinctly, but also should be capable of improvising at short notice, coordinating with other organisers, and using wit and humour appropriately to engage with both dignitaries and the general audience. The objective of this workshop was to prepare participants to take up the role of event host at various formal, semi-formal or casual events. Through interactive discussions and a series of practice exercises, the workshop helped participants to understand in detail the nuances of an MC/event host's role. Students engaged in detail with the basic skills involved, including pre-event tasks like research and scripting, and during-the-event responsibilities such as welcoming, introducing, announcing and audience engagement. Participants were also challenged to deal with different situations that an MC might encounter in real life, leading to an engaging as well as informative session. 31 participants attended the session, and each one of them participated enthusiastically in different activities during the workshop. This should stand them in good stead when they decide to take up such a role in the future, whether at university or in a future workplace.
