JKLU Laureate Award 2023 and Hari Shankar Singhania Memorial Oration

n April 14, 2023, JK Lakshmipat University, conferred the 8th JKLU Laureate Award to Padma Vibhushan Dr. R. A. Mashelkar, for his exemplary work in shaping Science, Technology and Innovation policies in post-liberalized India. The event was witnessed in person by over 500 guests and by another 500 people through live webcast. Dr. Mashelkar, former Director General of CSIR and Chairman of the National Innovation Foundation, is known for his world-class scientific research, transformative science and innovation institution leadership. He is also renowned for his pioneering different movements such as evolving global systems for traditional knowledge protection to helping create strong yet balanced IPR systems and inclusive innovation movement, based on the concept of Gandhian Engineering.

While welcoming the awardee, Vice Chancellor, Dr. Dheeraj Sanghi, thanked Dr. Mashelkar for his previous association with JKLU for helping students during exchange programs with different universities and said "When such a personality receives this award, it's not that he is being honoured; instead, he is honouring us by accepting this award". Pro-Chancellor, Shri H. P. Singhania, mentioned that our Laureate awardees are leaders in all walks of life and become role models for young minds and inspire them to excel in their own life. He also urged the youth to seize the opportunity for better nation-building. Dr. Mashelkar, who was touched by the affection received from JKLU's management, faculty and students, urged all the students to challenge their wisdom to create exponential innovation for society. During his Hari Shankar Singhania Memorial Oration on "Leap Frogging to Pole Vaulting: Creating the Exponential Entrepreneurs", he told the youth that rather than focusing on 'best practices', they should become trailblazers in setting up 'next practices'. He also asked everyone to challenge themselves with his Mashelkar Mantra, "Every morning, whether you are 18 or 80, say 'My best is yet to come' and that day can be today". The event, was moderated by Dr Ashwini Sharma and concluded with a vote of thanks from Pro Vice Chancellor Prof Asheesh Gupta. Post event, JKLU had organized a press conference, which was attended by over 30 journalists and media persons.









aipur Design Week (17th April to 23rd April 2023) is an exemplary, experiential and insightful Design Festival that serves the purpose of creating a constituency of Design in India. Thesix-day long' Jaipur Design Week 2023', was organized at JK Lakshmipat University campus from April 17 to 22, 2023, to celebrate the spirit of creativity and innovation in design, when various workshops, panel discussions and film screenings of students' work were showcased. While inaugurating the event, Dr. Dheeraj Sanghi, Vice Chancellor, JKLU mentioned the launch of the 'Emerging Designer of the Year' award and hoped it will inspire our design students to achieve their true potential. The festival featured a variety of activities showcasing the emerging trends and innovations in the design world. Several events and activities including Open Studios, Designathon, Thoughtspot, Workshops, Panel Discussions, Exhibit D, Design Haat, and a Pantone Party made the festival a gala affair. The event was organized under the supervision of Prof A Balasubramaniam, Director, Institute of Design, JKLU and President, Association of Designers of India.

The Open Studio was a four-day workshop open to everyone, where attendees were able to learn directly from industry and academic experts. This year's Designathon was carefully curated for school students and undergraduate design students to engage with hands-on design exercises and solve complex human problems. A fun-activity afternoon was organized for school children on Friday with Gaurav Juyal, the erstwhile anchor for Disney's Art Attack. An Atal Incubation Centre session, Design Week's "ThoughtSpot" was a platform to inspire students and educate them about emerging domains of Design. Leading designers who talked about the domains of Service Design, Healthcare Design, Brand Design, and innovation in entrepreneurship included Anthony Lopez of Lopez Design, a brand design firm, Manan Pahwa, a Service Design Specialist, Neeraj Kumar, a Bio Design fellow from Stanford University, and Nidhi Kachwaha, CEO of Atal Incubation Centre at JKLU. The forum discussion on 'Jaipur beyond Crafts' featured design experts, entrepreneurs, and filmmakers from Jaipur discussing their work and innovation in design domains beyond traditional craft



design. Schools from around the country also participated in competitions on designing installations on sustainability, graffiti on crafts, logo design and animation with Gaurav Juyal. Participants enjoyed working on design workshops with diverse courses such as Design Management, Healthcare Innovation, and Sustainable Dyeing, taught by industry and academic experts at the JKLU Campus, Jaipur. Other Speakers, Panelists and Experts included Prem Lokesh, Suruchi Sharma, Abhimanyu Singh, Kallol Mohanty, Aditi Anuj, Anant Agarwal, Shivatmika Lala and Chandrasekhar Bheda.

The grand finale of Jaipur Design Week, which was celebrated by the university along with the Association of Designers of India, was held on April 22, 2023. It witnessed a series of talks by famous designers and culminated with the 'Emerging Designer of the Year', award. Emerging Designer of the Year, which is presented to a young design professional doing extraordinary work in the field of design, was conferred upon U R Siddharth, a recent graduate of NID (National Institute of Design) Haryana and a Designer at Philips Innovation. Siddharth has won a record 85 international awards for his work from RED DOT, IF Germany and DNA Paris.

Affairs. Dr. Vijay Saraswat talked about various technical aspects of Artificial Intelligence such as Llama, GPT4 and BARD. The session was attended by faculty, staff, students of JKLU and also by many national and international academicians. Vice Chancellor Prof Dheeraj Sanghi enlightened the audience by his thought on the topic. The session was co-ordinated by Dr S Taruna, Professor, CSE department.

A nacademic forum session by Dr. Sameer Mittal was conducted on April 1, 2023. The title of the talk was "A Morphological Analysis for Designing Outcome-based Contracts". Dr Saurabh introduced PSS-Product-Service Systems and OBCs- Outcome-based Contracts and then presented the morphological analysis developed during the SNOBI (Systematic Development of Novel Business Models) project. He discussed the advantages of OBCs such as high sustainability, high revenue, and access to data, using everyday examples such as cars, refrigerators, air conditioning etc. He also explained types of OBCs and explored how the operations should be done in the era of 4.0 industrialization. Moreover, he emphasized how the PSS approach can develop a product-oriented model, especially taking the models of footwear industries. The session was thought-provoking and engaged faculties from all the departments in an interdisciplinary discussion.



Academic Forum on Metaverse in Financial System

An academic forum session by Dr Riya Surekha was conducted on April 29, 2023. The title of the talk was 'Metaverse in Financial System'. Dr Riya discussed integration of the 'Metaverse' into the financial system, anticipated to accelerate, driven by advancements in cryptocurrencies, nonfungible tokens (NFTs), and digital financial services. She discussed the current scope of the Metaverse in finance and the necessary infrastructural developments for its adoption. She explored the potential research hotspots to direct future academic inquiries and economic endeavors.

Research Workshop on "Systematic literature review and Bibliometric analysis"

A two-day online research workshop was conducted by Institute of Management, JK Lakshmipat University on "Systematic literature review and Bibliometric analysis" on April 1st and 2nd, 2023. Dr Riya Sureka from JKLU's Institute of Management was the resource person of the workshop. On the first day, she covered the fundamentals and conceptual understanding of systematic review of literature, bibliometric

analysis and explained the need of doing a quality review in academic research. On the second day, she explained the PRISMA method and helped the participants get familiar with R- Biblioshiny and VOS Viewer software.



Total 71 registrations were received with participants from various prominent universities like BITS Pilani, University of Jammu, Manipal University, Chandigarh University, Mody University of Science and Technology, Amity University, Asian Business School, Lovely Professional University, etc. The session was moderated by Dr. Monika Soni from Institute of Management, JKLU. Interactive session with crisp presentation provided maximum benefits to the participants who gave very positive feedback about the workshop.

Pre-orientation Session on Introduction to Programming and Online platforms



Workshop on 'What's your Identity? An Exploration through Storytelling'



he Centre for Communication and Critical Thinking at JK Lakshmipat University organised a workshop titled "What's your Identity? An Exploration through Storytelling', on April 15, 2023. The workshop was conducted by Ms. Meghana Koppala, a Creative Director, Copywriter, and Storyteller, who has worked in the film industry as well, and has been teaching courses on Storytelling in various universities. Presenting oneself and one's ideas in an engaging manner is a challenge that most graduates will have to face at some point in their professional careers, and at the same time, it is something that, if successful, has the potential to make a significant difference to their progress. Convincing presentations end up being more than just presentations – they are stories that speak to an individual's identity and journey of development. Effective storytelling through presentations is thus an essential skill that can differentiate a student from others. The objective of this workshop was to help students learn how to leverage storytelling techniques to effectively present themselves and their ideas. The morning session of the workshop started with a demonstration of how most regular slide presentations end up being boring, and hence how the power of storytelling and visuals can be used to make them lively and more interesting. The speaker highlighted the importance of "reading visuals, seeing words, and making connections" to create a cohesive story, and thereby communicate better. The afternoon session focused on ways to make a pitch deck more interesting. This included personifying characters, leaving space for the audience's imagination, making their mind move, and eventually creating the core of the story/presentation that is being made. The students were also asked to engage in a brainstorming exercise for generating and organizing ideas, which some of them were then invited to present. They were also given an assignment on communicating their identity. With a series of lively examples from her own life, the speaker managed to leave the audience with several helpful guidelines to light their path towards presenting their identity better through storytelling.
