



Eligibility Criteria

- A minimum of 60% aggregate marks in Class XII in English and three subjects of the applicant's choice but subjects with internal marks of 50 percent or higher will not be counted
- Students in their final examination of class XII may apply; however, admission will be provisional, subject to achieving the minimum marks
- Applicants are required to appear for JK-DET as their entrance exam for qualifying for admission to JKLU
- Marks awarded by a recognized Central/State Board/University Examination in India or any foreign country recognized as equivalent to the 10+2 system by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) will be considered
- Foreign Nationals/Persons of Indian Origin/Non-Resident of Indian candidates can be considered for admission based on their marks in 10+2 or equivalent examination only

Scholarships

For the Bachelor of Design program (B. Des.), the scholarship will be determined based on three criterias

Additional Scholarship

Moreover, there is a fee reduction initiative for certain student categories, capped at a maximum of 100 percent. A 25% reduction in academic fees is applied to the following individuals:

- Wards of a staff member of JKLU or any entity associated with JKO
- Sibling of a student (both receive a fee reduction)
- · Sibling of an alumna/alumnus
- An alumnus pursuing a second degree

Exceptional Performance in Extracurricular and Co-curricular Activities

If an applicant demonstrates outstanding performance in sports (such as representing the state in national-level sports), Olympiad (reaching the Training Camp level), or any other area, a special committee will assess the application and recommend additional scholarships.

Women Scholarships

- All women students will receive a scholarship equivalent to 10 percent of the academic fee if they are ineligible for any above-mentioned scholarships
- · This award is granted annually, subject to the conditions outlined in the rules for continuation

Special Category Scholarships

Students falling into the following categories will be entitled to a scholarship equivalent to 10 percent of the academic fee in the first year if they do not qualify for any above-mentioned scholarships. This is applicable only for the initial year of studies:

- Wards of defense personnel
- SC/ST students
- Differently-abled students
- Students from North-eastern states (domicile based on the school's address in the 12th class, and for open school, the address of the exam center in the 12th class)
- Students from all Union Territories (except Delhi), with domicile determined by the same rule as above
- Students from JKO schools

Early Bird Scholarships

In addition to the existing scholarships, including women scholarships and special category scholarships (subject to a maximum of 100 percent), JKLU offers Early Bird Scholarships.

- In Round 1, an extra 15 percent scholarship will be granted
- In Round 2, an additional 10 percent scholarship will be provided
- In Round 3, an extra 5 percent scholarship will be awarded

All scholarships are expressed as a percentage of Academic Fees exclusively. No scholarship covers Technology Fees, Hostel, Transport, and Mess charges.





- Hostel charges are on an annual basis
- Hostel charges for one academic year and the students are not allowed to leave the hostel during the semester
- The hostel fee, as above, applies to all boarding students
- Hostel rooms are on a twin-sharing basis. Hostel charges are subject to yearly revision
- A hostel security deposit of ₹5,000 would be payable along with the first year's fee and is refundable at the time of leaving the hostel

MESS FACILITIES

Hygienic and healthy food is prepared in-house and served in a centrally located mess adjacent to the hostels. The mess is managed and run by a Mess Committee that has both students and faculty members

TRANSPORT

AC Bus Facility | Rs. 45,000/- per year (Subject to change). Applicable if the student wishes to avail of the JKLU transport facility from Jaipur City to the JKLU campus on specified routes. This is subject to yearly revision.

SPORTS

From inter-university sports competitions to intramural events, JKLU offers abundant outdoor and indoor activities throughout the year. The most cherished student experiences are out in the open. The university cricket and basketball teams regularly participate in inter-college sports events held on and off campus. The students also get to engage in several indoor sports activities like chess and table tennis.

FITNESS CENTRE

The fitness centre, strategically located within the hostel complex, allows students easy access to a well-equipped gym where they can work out at their own convenience. JKLU also endeavors to provide ample opportunities and facilities for sports and games activities for the holistic development of each student, and the range of sports activities provided on campus is a testimony to that.

HEALTH CARE

JKLU has a team of qualified doctors and healthcare staff at the university medical centre to provide round-the-clock medical assistance and healthcare to the students and staff. Our healthcare professionals conduct regular health checkups & follow ups along with a range of wellness services that help foster a healthy and happy JKLU community. CAFETERIA

Worried about those in-between hunger-pangs and munch-cravings? Head to the multi-cuisine cafeteria and grab your favourite snack on the go. Due to state government guidelines, the cafeteria could not be made operational following the pandemic. Restrictions were lifted on April 22 and we plan to make the cafeteria fully functional in the new academic year. So far, our mess vendor has been running the facility, but this year, we plan to go self-reliant where the cafeteria will be managed and operated by a team of our students and staff to give the inmates the feeling of a true home stay.


