International Conference on 'Innovation and Sustainability'

The conference comprised 3 luminaries 5 keynote speakers, 5 plenary speakers, 26 technical session chairs with 8 tracks spread across 13 sessions. Chief Guest for the Inaugural Mr. R Ramanan, Mission Director, AIM, NITI Aayog, Govt. of India, delivered the Inaugural address. General co -chair Prof. Amit Sheth, University of California talked about Sustainability and Artificial Intelligence. Dr. Sanjay Goel, Conference Chair and Director, IET apprised of the conference. Mr. Asheesh Gupta, Pro Vice Chancellor briefed the Innovative and Sustainable Teaching and Learning of JKLU. Dr. Jyotiprakash CR Naidu, Dean Research and Development talked about Integration of Design, Management and Technology for Innovative and Sustainable Practices. Mr. A Balasubramaniam introduced on how design is the key for innovation and sustainability. ACADEMIC ROUND-UP

SESSIONS CONDUCTED BY CENTRE FOR POLICY STUDIES OF GLOBAL PUBLIC POLICY PROGRAM 2021

Centre for Policy Studies conducted the Global Public Policy series in collaboration with the School of Public Policy at the University of Massachusetts Amherst. The certificate programme delivered over 5 power-packed and interactive sessions covering contemporary global policy themes ranging from technology, AI & climate change to power-balance & role of civic actors and helped young leaders understand and engage in a dialogue on public policy research with leading minds in these areas. Organized and moderated by Ms. Palak Sharma, we were privileged to have esteemed faculty members from UMass Amherst enlighten the attendees with their research experience in the USA and understanding of the world polices.

- Challenges of Policymaking in the Twenty-First Century by Alasdair Roberts | Director of School of Public Policy - UMass Amherst on February 13, 2021. The session revolved around the following broad topics in the field of Public Policy: The craft of Policy Analysis. What India and US have in common. A detailed discussion on Six Challenges. How to tackle these challenges. A total of 182 participants attended the session and had discussions around the differences in policymaking in India and the US & the role that federal structure plays around policy making and implementation.
- The Moon, the Ghetto and Artificial Intelligence: Enacting Digital Government by Jane Fountain on February 20, 2021 | Distinguished University Professor of Public Policy in the College of Information and Computer Sciences - UMass Amherst. The speaker addressed the session in the aspects of Government in the Information Age, Connecting Technologies to citizenship, Technology Enactment – An analytical framework Computation Algorithms and systemic bias, Discrimination in the Age of Algorithms, Big Data's Disparate Impact. The session was attended by 110 viewers from India, US & Australia. Most questions revolved on the use of AI & Machine Learning in policy spheres and a good discussion revolved around the Indian context of privacy, policy and data analysis.
- How Can Cities Be Made More Resilient for Climate Change? by Thaddeus Miller | Associate Professor School of Public Policy - UMass Amherst on February 27, 2021. Prof Miller, with his experience in resilience building sector, beginning from the Anthropocene. He talked about the interaction between acceleration in Earth trends and the socio- economic trend resulting in the pressure on resilience infrastructure.
- Mortar and Wheels: The Role of Non-profits in Policy by Juniper Katz | Assistant Professor, School of Public Policy - UMass Amherst on February 27, 2021. Prof Katz, spoke about her own research design, the related questions in context of United States on the competing images of the role that non profit's play in the policy process and the civic society. She talked about the private property right ethics and the development of voluntary giving up of land in the US. Her research focused on land trust's and their interaction with citizens. A total of 97 users attended the session and a very interesting conversation on land rights in India, and the role of non-profits in climate resilience followed.
- Using Carbon Pricing to Achieve an Equitable Energy Transition by Michael Ash | Professor, School of Public Policy & Department of Economics - UMass Amherst on February 28, 2021. Prof Ash talks about post World War fossil fuel emission rates and the increasing climate related global problem. He then presented the different lenses on national responsibility that the world needs to take up. Prof Ash then focussed on what countries can do to address minor policy challenges that affect their citizens with climate change. In contrast, he also addressed the issues of free-riders problem and shared responses to questions on using the doughnut economy model.
- Controlling Corporate Power by Lenore Palladino | Assistant Professor, School of Public Policy & Department of Economics - UMass Amherst on February 28, 2021. Prof Lenore conducted the session on the importance of multinational corporations on our lives all over the globe. She used evidence-based policy data to give perspectives on how corporations work in a democracy and how does the federal structure in the US context. She shared data on wealth groups, shareholder promising and democratically contextualized corporations. A total of 102 total viewers attended the session and a very thoughtful discussion process followed with due focus on taxation on corporations and the green economy that climate change demands. In most sessions, we found attendees from all parts of India, from various academic institutions, with zealous questions and answers on active policymaking issues in India and the global level.

Session on 'Budget 2021-22: Reviving Growth of Indian Economy'

Value-added Course on React JS & React Native by JKLU alumni

REACTJS & REACT NATIVE is a Value-added course of 30 hours that was organised by SPARKS Coding Club for the student of JKL Lakshimpit University that commenced on March 14, 2021

concluded on April 6, 2021. The React is an open-source, front end, JavaScript library for building user interfaces or UI components and can be used as a base in the development of single-page or mobile applications. React Native is powering the mobile revolution and is a critical skill that developers use to innovate and reach more users on mobile platforms. Program on Designing student centered learning experience Summer Institute 2021 at Franklin W. Olin Engineering College, Boston



A team of six faculty members and four students from JK Lakshmipat University attended the five-day Summer Institute at Franklin W. Olin Engineering college, Boston. The program started on June 7, 2021 and was held in virtual mode, where faculty members designed new courses using Project Based Learning (PBL) Pedagogy. Olin College of Engineering is ranked #3 in the nation among undergraduate engineering programs, according to the just-released 2020 U.S. New college rankings. JK Lakshmipat University has been a pioneer in introducing this experiential learning pedagogy in India since 2018 for two batches. The new faculty who have joined the institute in the last two years are being trained in this pedagogy. Several courses on cutting edge technology like Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning are being developed for delivery using PBL. The university plans to transform courses in various programs using the pedagogy. The faculty and students attending this program belong to the three institutes: the Institute of Engineering and Technology, the Institute of Management and the Institute of Design using PBL.

HANDS-ON LEARNING IN FUNDAMENTALS OF AUTOMATION ENGINEERING

Teaching Engineering curriculum with hands-on activities is essential and can be implemented in innovative ways. The students at various universities are attending online classes since the pandemic started, however their learning will be incomplete without experience on performing hands-on activities and projects. The students of first year engineering program at JK Lakshmipat University are studying a course on Fundamentals of Automation Engineering. In this course students will develop projects for automation and necessary skills are developed. The university has sent the students the hardware boards and sensors to perform activities and develop projects safely using low power components. The MSP430 microcontroller boards have been sponsored by Texas Instruments India Ltd and the skill development is endorsed by All India Council for Technical Education, Government of India.

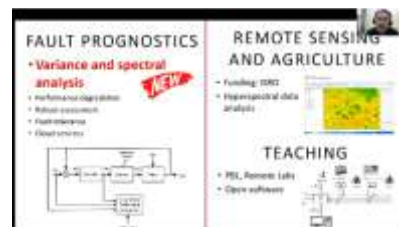
Session on 'How to Give Back to Society and How to Make Your Mark in Life'

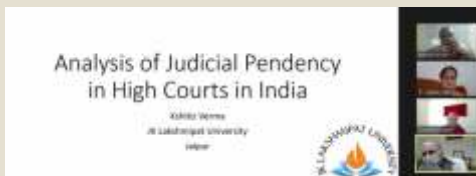
ACADEMIC FORUM SEMINAR SERIES

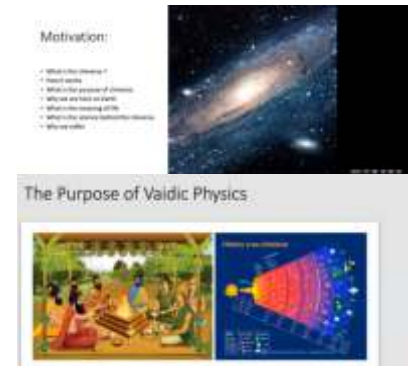
Session on 'Analysis of Judicial Pendency in High Courts in India'

He presented his research on the data collected from the National Judicial Data Grid, which has been lauded by the likes of the World Bank and helped India jump in its ranking on ease of doing business. The key takeaways from this talk were: The pending cases in most of the high courts are increasing linearly with time; the case load on judges in various high courts is very unevenly distributed, making judges of some high courts hundred times more loaded than others, for some high courts it may take even a hundred years to clear the pendency cases if proper measures are not taken. Session on "The purpose of Vaidic Physics"

Session on 'Personal Effectiveness'



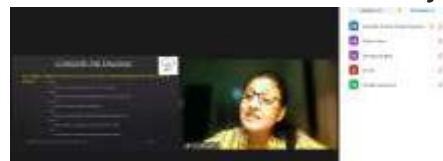

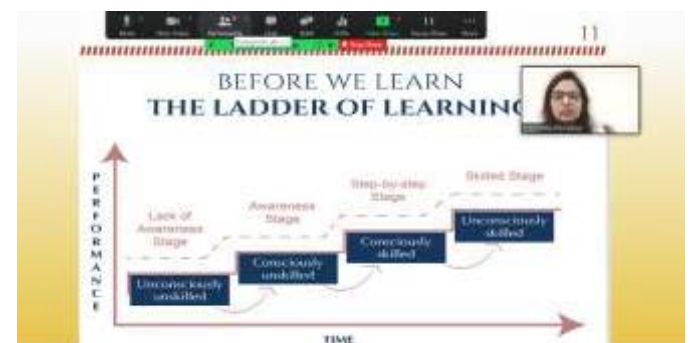
Session on 'Communicate to Win'

Inauguration of Swachh Bharat Awareness Drive

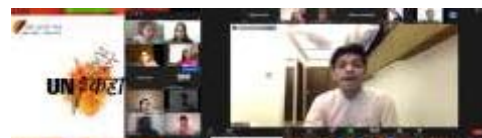

The Online Fest by JKLU



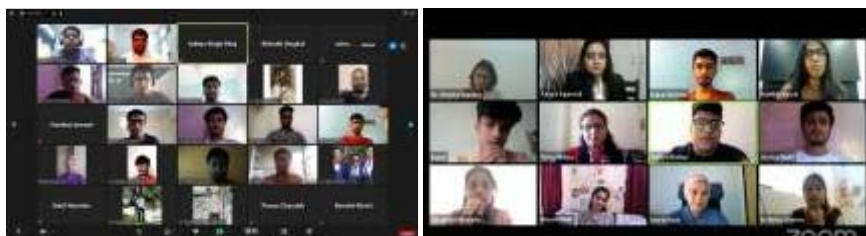

Session on 'Career Prospects in Engineering Management'



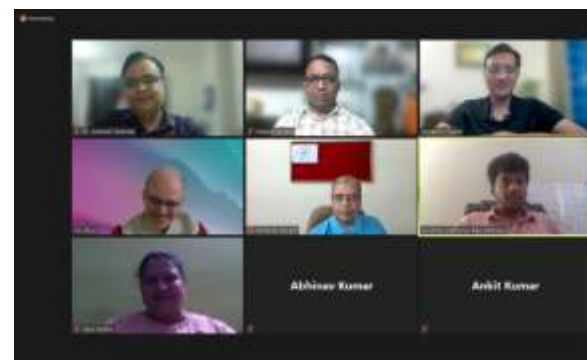

Student Participation in CII First Edition of Rajasthan Startup Summit 2021

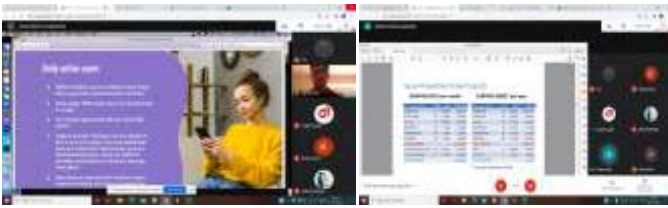

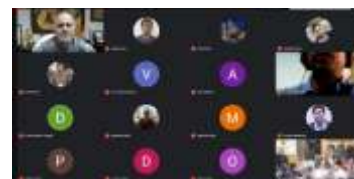

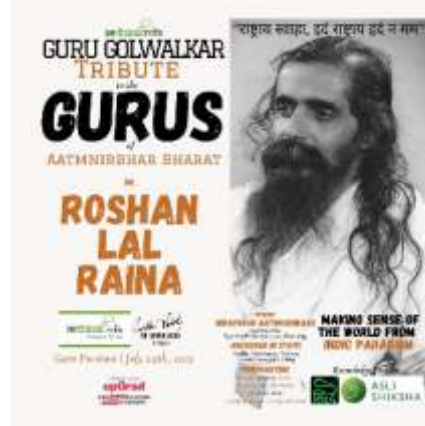

Thakur, presented 'Fuzzy Control using Python and Node-Red : Application to Truck backer-upper problem' in the National Symposium and Research Colloquium, organized by IEEE SB GCE and IEEE IA/IE/PELS Jt. Chapter Kerala, in Sep '21. In this work, a new fuzzy control framework, based on a Python kernel and Node-RED platform, is proposed. To illustrate its performance, it is applied to solve the truck backer-upper problem, which is a well-known complex non-linear benchmark. A Node-Red dashboard is used to setup and launch simulations. Truck state variables are also displayed in this dashboard, so that the user can assess controller performance. The fuzzy inference system is designed using Python libraries (Skfuzzy). Modbus TCP/IP protocol was used for communication between the simulation system and the Node-Red platform. In future, it is expected this framework will be used to interact with a real autonomous vehicle.
