SMART INDIA HACKATHON (SIH 2022)



PARTNERS



Smart India Hackathon (SIH) is a nationwide initiative by Ministry of Education's Innovation Cell to provide students a platform to solve pressing real life problems of the government and society. It is the world's biggest open innovation model. In its 5th edition, this year, JK Lakshmipat University Jaipur (JKLU), was selected as one of 75 Nodal Centers across the country and only one of three in Rajasthan, by the Ministry of Education's Innovation Cell and All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), to host the Grand Finale of SIH 2022 on August 25 and 26, 2022 in a 36 hour non-stop journey. JKLU hosted the Software Edition of the Hackathon. 28 teams having over 200 participants, competed with each other on 7 Problem Statements given by the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs and Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment. Each problem statement had a winning amount of Rs 1 lakh. JKLU started the grand festival with a Launch and Press Conference on August 24, which was attended by Vice Chancellor Dr Dheeraj Sanghi, Dr Amit Sinhal, Dr Umesh Gupta, Mr SR Pandey and Mr Shounak Biswas.



Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, Shri Narendra Modi, interacted over video conference with participants of the hackathon across the country on 25th evening. Earlier on 25th August, at the Inauguration of the event, Dr Dheeraj Sanghi, Vice Chancellor, JKLU welcomed dignitaries and participants and said that it was a proud moment for the university to be amongst the chosen few to host such a prestigious event. Ms Binita Thakur, IPS, AD Police, Police HQ, Jaipur was the Chief Guest at the inauguration. The inaugural program also had Mr Yogesh Agarwal, Global Head, Learning & Development, Wipro as Guest of Honour and Mr Deepak Choubey, Nodal Centre Head from the Ministry of Education to oversee the event.

She advocated that teams should be multi and transdisciplinary to have a 360 degree view and arrive at a more holistic decision making. The Valedictory session of the grand finale also had Dr Mohan Lal Goel, Managing Director, Robo MQ as the Guest of Honour, who shared words of wisdom and encouraged participants to find real-life solutions which could germinate into viable and sustainable startups and congratulated the winners of the hackathon. Coursera Launch Event



Institute of Engineering and Technology, JKLU organised the Coursera Launch Event-Learning Without Limits on September 5, 2022. This event marked the collaboration of JK Lakshmi Pat University with Coursera. The event was attended by Vice Chancellor, Dr Dheeraj Sanghi, Director IET, Dr Sanjay Goel, the Coursera team, faculty members and BTech students.

The event was divided into two phases, the first was for the second year onwards BTech students, and the other was explicitly for the first year BTech students. Poorna Bhatti (2nd year BTech) welcomed the dignitaries and students. Dr Dheeraj Sanghi presented the keynote speech highlighting the journey of this collaboration. Thereafter, the Coursera team conducted a small quiz to make the session interactive and distributed small goodies to the top ten winners. Then the campus ambassadors were introduced to the first-year students, and new nominations were sought for campus ambassadors from the first year. The event ended with a vote of thanks by Sparsh Agarwal (BTech 4th Year), Coursera Campus Ambassador. ACADEMIC ROUND-UP

Academic Forum Session on Policy and Design



An academic forum session by Dr Devanuj Balkrishan was conducted on Friday, September 2, 2022. The title of the talk was 'Policy and Design'. Dr Devanuj highlighted the importance of design in policymaking and comprehensively dealt with the direction towards achieving change. He has extensively discussed the policy cycle including agenda setting, formulation of alternatives, selection of policy alternatives, policy design and implementations. He has explored 4 major perspectives on understanding design in policy-making: viz diverse viewpoints, systematic complexity, dynamic change and power differential. He debunked the stereotypical definitional understanding of design and explore the larger spectrum. He emphasized on thinking systematically, looking from multiple perspectives, and thinking through making.

Workshop on Profile Writing



Centre for Communication and Critical Thinking at JKLU organized a workshop on "Profile Writing" for 1st year students on September 2, 2022. The workshop's facilitator was Mr. Kartik Bajoria, a writer, columnist, and communications instructor. Mr. Bajoria started the workshop with an engaging and interesting ice-breaking activity. The participants were given a structure to craft their individual profiles. At the end of the workshop, participants created their own profile using the structure shared by the facilitator. The facilitator provided feedback to each participant after they shared their profiles with everyone. The workshop gave an opportunity to participants to introspect and get to know themselves better. A total of 59 students registered for the workshop, and close to 50 of those attended the workshop.

Be A Critic – A Centre for Communication & Critical Thinking Event



The Centre for Communication and Critical Thinking organised an event, "Be A Critic," on September 6, 2022, from 5:30 pm onwards. The venue for the same was MDC-Training Room 002. In this event the participation was done through a registration form. 30+ students registered, out of which 15 participants participated. A short inspirational movie "You Changed Me," directed by Sudeesh Kanuajia and Produced by Azad Jain was screened. The students were shown the movie and asked to write down their observations and present their views. The event was judged by Dr Saurabh Singanapalli, Assistant Professor at the Centre for Communication and Critical Thinking. The event ended with students interacting with Dr Saurabh and taking individual feedback for improving their critical lenses.

Distinguished Lecture by Dr Sudhir KJain, Vice Chancellor of Banaras Hindu University

Dr Sudhir K. Jain, Vice Chancellor of Banaras Hindu University addressed a session at JK LakshmiPat University, Jaipur on September 12, 2022. He is the 28th vice Chancellor of Banaras Hindu University and a few of his achievements include intensive research in design courses, dynamics of buildings, and earthquake engineering focus in developing countries.

He started the discussion with interaction about the Fundamentals of entrepreneurship and the skill sets required. His key learnings gave students an environment of being independent thinkers and problem solvers. He made the audience believe in the power of being a good human and following the ethical code of conduct. Portraying various real-life examples, he gave specific take aways that would help our students to nurture an entrepreneurial mind-set and think more critically. Session on Countering Cybercrime by Central Detective Training Institute, Jaipur



A session on Countering Cyber crime was conducted by Central Detective Training Institute, Jaipur and organised by Institution's Innovation Council, JK Lakshmipat University on September 12, 2022. Around 150 students of BTech and BCA attended the session. Chief Guest of the event, Dr Amandeep Singh Kapoor, Director CDTI, addressed the students and told them about how criminals misuse today's technologies, how he deals with cyber criminals and his experience with them. He also told them how the department of CDTI works. Speaker of the event, Cyber Operations Consultant, Mr Mukesh Choudhary spoke about his past experiences, including how he caught brilliant criminals and some case studies, what mistakes we make in our daily life which motivate cyber crime what to do and what not to do. He showed practically how network swapping is done and also conducted a Q&A session. From this session, students came to know about the crucial information of cyber world from the experts. During the session lots of real-life examples were discussed and students became more aware about cyber attacks and how they are executed in today's world. In the end, a 15 minute quiz was done and winners were rewarded. The event was coordinated by Dr Amit Sinhal and a student team consisting of Mridul Goyal, Vansh Jaiswal, Parasmeet Kaur, Niharika Sharma, Kush Charan and Jatin Choudhary.





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
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
